The big difference that our patients comment on is that there are a lot more smiles and it's a more relaxing, homely environment. In fact, because of the less clinical, stress-free environment on board, the specialist nurses on board say that many patients can tolerate their treatments better.</p> <p>Our units are easily accessible, they are stationed in convenient, large spaces like those in a supermarket or community hospital car parks where parking is often free.</p> <p>Our mobile cancer care units provide relaxing surroundings with four comfortable treatment chairs and a kitchen and bathroom facilities where NHS specialist-trained nurses administer the same medications that the patient would receive inside the hospital. Our mobile cancer care units combine the friendliness and comfort that patients want closer to home along with the standard of treatment, they deserve and require.</p>
